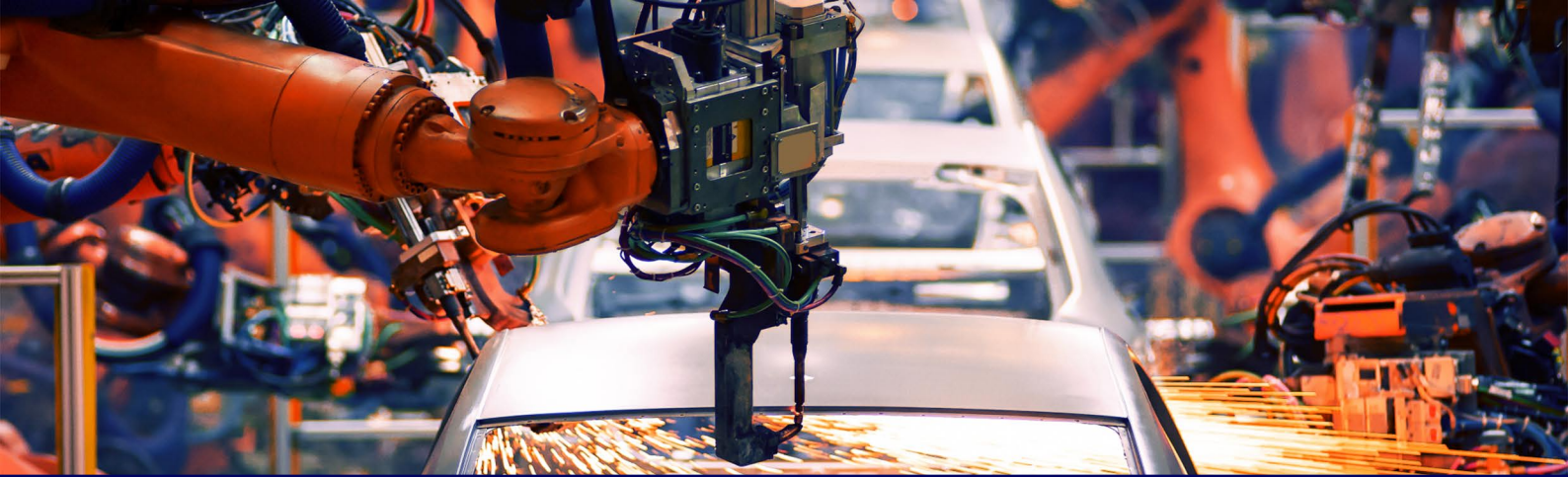


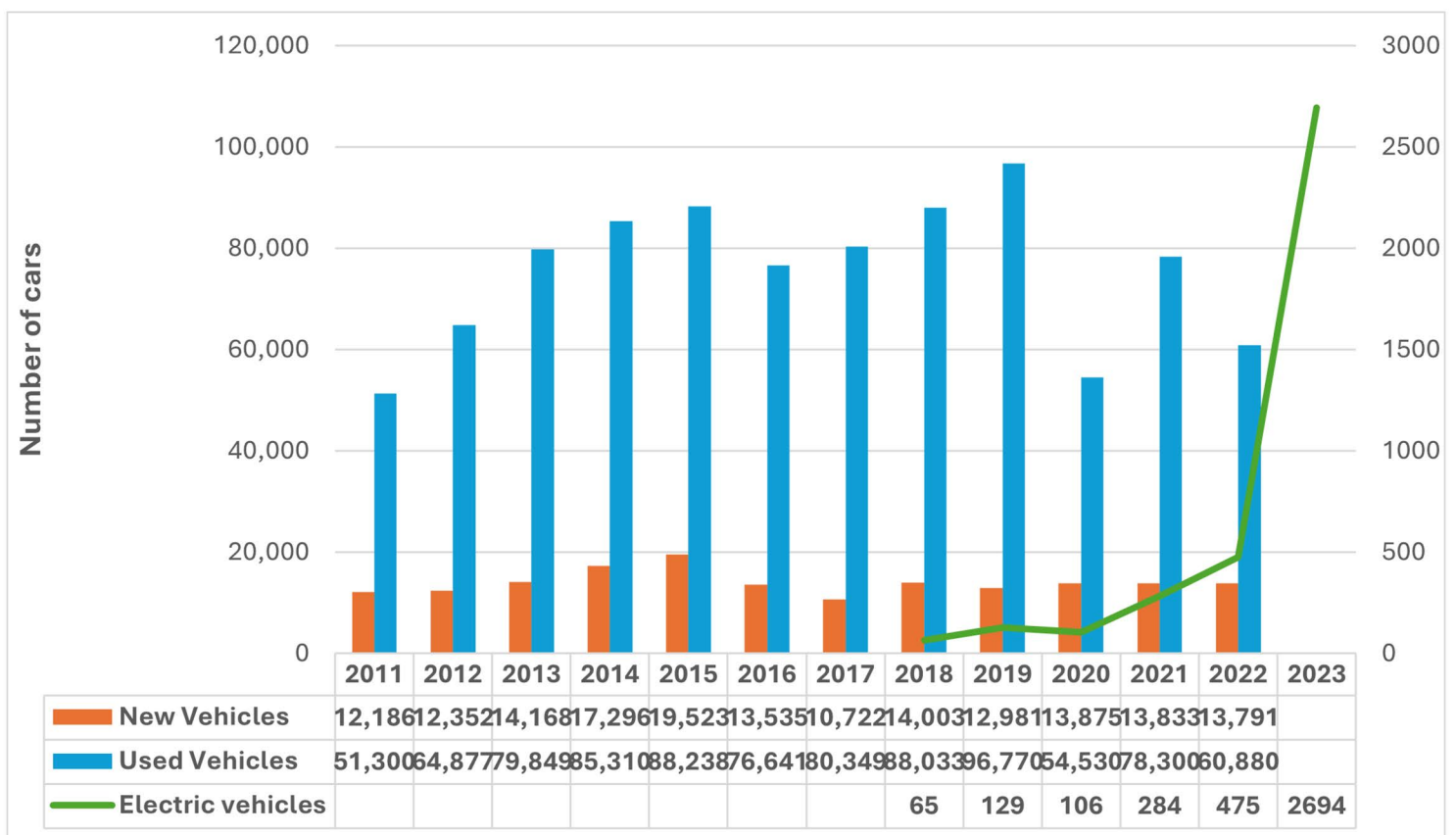


The Future of Industrialization in the Context of the second-hand Economy.

B1: Interventions to drive local textile and clothing industry.

- ▲ Develop criteria to differentiate between used imported textiles and textiles for waste.
- ▲ Establish textile and fabric value addition centers and equip them with affordable infrastructure services including electricity.
- ▲ Revamp and modernize local ginneries such as Kisumu Cotton Mill, (KICOMI) as well as Rivatex Textile and Athi River textile hub.
- ▲ Establish modern cooperative society for ginneries and cotton growers.
- ▲ Adopt and implement a certified cotton seed system to enhance cotton production.
- ▲ Build capacity for textile industry players on fashion and design of clothing and textile products.
- ▲ Develop a National Policy on Textiles and Apparel.
