


Figure 1: Share (%) of county in national industry sector (Gross Value added) 1.31 1.32 127 1.28 1.25



Figure 2: Share of manufacturing sub-sector in county industrial sector (Gross Value added)





Figure 4: Share of employment in county manufacturing sub-sector (2021)

Figure 3: Gross Value-added Growth in county Manufacturing sub-sector








Figure 7: Share of employment in county construction sub-sector (2021)




Figure 5: Share of construction sub-sector in county industrial sector (Gross Value added)






Figure 6: Gross Value-added Growth in county construction sub-sector

Figure 8: Share of Mining and quarrying sub-sector in county





Figure 9: Gross Value-added Growth in county mining and quarrying sub-sector
